The Diabetes Research Center, opened Aug. 23, 2014, it occupies 1.5 floors within the John and Mary Pappajohn Biomedical Discovery Building. A team of 100 researchers works daily conducting a variety of research studies centered around maintaining, preventing and, ultimately, curing diabetes.

August's Charity of the Month is the D.D. DUNLAP KIDNEY FUND. The D.D. Dunlap Kidney Fund was established at the 1978 FOE International Convention to raise funds for grants to universities, hospitals and other institutions involved in kidney research and related projects. Through the years, millions of dollars have been granted to various hospitals and medical centers for research programs through the Kidney Fund.
