FROM THE TRUSTEES:

At the FOE #2272, we like to think of ourselves as family. And we want our family to grow. In order to do that, we need to increase our membership.

If you are a visitor, you may notice that you are being charged an additional \$0.50 for your drinks. We understand that you may not want to be charged that additional \$0.50... and we have a simple way for you to change that: Become a Member of Either the Aerie or Auxiliary!

By paying the \$10.00 Initiation Fee (one time only) and \$39.00 in annual dues, you can avoid paying that pesky \$0.50 per drink. So, if you buy eight drinks a month for a year, you recoup that money in lower drink prices, as well as become a part of our Eagles family!

For an Auxiliary membership it is even less than that. For a \$24.00 annual fee and a \$10.00 (one time only) initiation fee, you may become part of our Auxiliary Eagles family.

As a member you are eligible to join any of our clubs within the club: the Eagle Riders, the Sportsmen Club, REAC (Retired Eagles Activity Club) and the Auxiliary Drill and Ritual Team. We also have a 3-Ball Pool League and many other fund raising groups within our non-profit organization. All of the money we raise goes to charities throughout the area and across the country.

As an example, the Eagles funded a multi-million dollar Diabetes Research Center at the University of Iowa... and part of that money came from our club. Wouldn't you like to be a member of an organization like that?
